



New Features of ExitCare® version 7.0

ExitCare System

Microsoft SQL Database Structure – The most significant change to ExitCare version 7.0 is the change to the MS-SQL database structure. There have been very few screen/function changes, so most Users will not see a difference in the screens and functions they use. (See below for changes to be aware of). This change to MS-SQL is expected to generally result in faster and more stable performance. It also brings ExitCare into line with the interests of most Customers to provide a product based on MS-SQL.

Security System, Reset User Passwords – There is now the ability to provide a way for a User, or for a Help Desk tech, to be able to reset a User's password. This is a separate right that a User can have without the ability to affect other security settings.

Internet Updating – There is now the ability to download and install updates (document only and program updates/patches) over the Internet (ExitCare Version 7.x only). When an update is available and a computer running ExitCare is connected to the Internet, there will be a notice of the update availability in the status bar at the bottom of the ExitCare application. Clicking this notice allows a User to download and run the update.

Internet Updating Security Setting – There is an additional Security Setting to allow (or not allow) a User to download/apply Internet Updates to ExitCare.

“Reprint” Watermark on Archive Prints – From the Options settings in ExitCare this can be set to automatically print or not print.

Print Settings for Forms vs. Documents – In the Department Print Settings screen in the Options System, you can now set different print counts for forms and documents.

DOB Field in Patient Archive – There is now a field showing for Patient Date of Birth when viewing records to select from the Patient Archive.

Drug Default Setups – User created defaults (as opposed to those supplied with the software) show up in the default drug list in a red font color.

DEA Number Printing – There is now a setting in the Department Print Settings screen in the Options System to 1) Always print the DEA number on the prescriptions, or 2) Only print DEA number on Schedule 2 drugs, or 3) Never print the DEA number on prescriptions.

Refill Number Default – ExitCare will now come with a default setting for refills of “Zero”, to accommodate the most common usage.

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NY State Rx Form Change – To meet the requirements of NY, there is now a patient gender listed on the Rx form.

ExitMeds Report Adds Patient Drug Allergy Listing – The ExitMeds form that prints out for pre-discharge medication reconciliation review now lists the Patient's drug allergies in the header of the form.

NDC Numbers – The ExitCare database of drug information now includes NDC numbers (from First DataBank, our drug information vendor). This is expected to primarily affect Software Partners of ExitCare that launch ExitCare from within their own clinical application, allowing the sending of drug data from their drug database and matching that information with drug data from the ExitCare (First DataBank) database.
